

REMEMBERING Mary Hamm

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of our loving mother, Mary Hamm, at the age of 94. Mary was born in Yarrow, BC, to Cornelius and Susan (Thiessen) Derksen.

Mary left school early to help her mother care for her siblings, often assisting her father with his businesses. In retirement, she continued her long-time volunteer work at MCC, traveled the world, curled twice a week, completed many puzzles, and enjoyed watching her soap operas on TV.

Mary was predeceased by her ex-husband Hank Hamm, three sons-in-law and all but one of her nine siblings. She leaves behind her son Jim Hamm, daughters Barbara Hill, Betty Ann Salloway, and Marilyn Motut, along with six grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her brother Jake Derksen and sister-in-law Velma (Abe) Derksen.
