Roger John Mawdsley passed away peacefully on February 21, 2024 at Chilliwack General Hospital. He is survived by his wife Beth; niece Megan Locke and grand-niece Charlotte. His sister Anne, and only sibling, predeceased him.

Roger was born in Crosby, England on December 6, 1948 but was brought to Belleville, Ontario as an infant.
