his wife at his side, he died peacefully after an intense 8-week battle with brain cancer on June 21, 2023.

they were married there in 1960 and then were blessed with 3 children.

Victor was a kind and gentle person who loved both family and church. He was deeply committed to

servicing others, especially the local community of Richmond. He was always grateful to God for being

able to live in Canada.
